EIGHT HOURS PROJECT

Eight Hours Project is a programme of discrete events taking place on 22nd and 26th February in the Project Arts Centre foyer. Taking the form of small encounters between Project Arts Centre personnel and members of an assembled panel of enthusiasts, the programme will consist of presentations and discussions on an eclectic mix of topics and activities. The overall time period of eight hours is based on the length of a typical working day. The programme is conceived as a gentle appropriation of time and attention away from scheduled work and towards an activity of more ambiguous value.

The identity of panel members and the topics and activities presented will not be made known in advance. Once the programme of encounters is complete further information will be circulated for the interest of all the participants.

Eight Hours Project is a component of Invisible, a Black Church Print Studio exhibition, curated by Oliver Dowling, John Graham and Margaret O'Brien, and presented at a number of locations throughout Dublin city (12/02/2010 – 04/03/2010).
